This letter is in response to an email on September 14, 2007 regarding zinc application rates on the Wolftrack website. This letter also addresses concerns discussed in a recent meeting on March 16, 2009, and a letter received on March 25, 2009, regarding efficiency claims made on the Wolftrax Inc website.

We have worked with personnel at Wolftrack to address your concern regarding their zinc products and efficiency claims. Consequently, Wolftrax Inc has removed the information regarding efficiency values from their website.

Efficacy studies were provided by Wolftrax to substantiate their zinc products. A review of this information substantiates the products are fertilizing materials that provide the zinc micronutrient to plants.
